Facility Description

Total Forest Industries LP. (TFI) produces pressure treated wood products, such as boards and ornamental fittings, for residential, commercial and industrial wood decking, fences and landscaping. Wood is received, dried, cut to length and width or machined to articles, inserted into pressurized baths containing preservative chemicals, held for a specified time for impregnation, withdrawn and drained, dried and packaged for shipment.

Substances Information

Copper (CAS number 7440-50-8, NPRI number NA-06) is a component of the wood preserving chemical. The majority of the copper remains in the wood product after treatment, while a small amount is disposed in sawdust sweepings and chemical wastes.

No amendments or changes have been made to the facility's toxics reduction plans.


